### To apply to UNI, please follow instructions below.

Your complete application file must be received by our department, including all documents listed below, by the deadline to be considered. The deadlines for Fall and Spring Admissions are as follows:

**Deadline for Fall Admission: January 20th**

**Deadline for Spring Admission: September 15<sup>th</sup>**

- MUST DO THIS FIRST** Application for Graduate Study, online <http://www.uni.edu/admissions/apply/>  
This needs to be in the system BEFORE your other items will be linked to your application. *(We cannot find you in the system without you completing this application first.)* You can upload the other documents by emailing them to [AdmissionsProcessing@uni.edu](mailto:AdmissionsProcessing@uni.edu).
- Application fee [**UNI students select UNI Alumni—you will NOT need to pay the fee**]
- Unofficial transcripts** can be uploaded in the application system or emailed to [AdmissionsProcessing@uni.edu](mailto:AdmissionsProcessing@uni.edu) (include name/ID in email). **Official transcripts** will need to be sent if you are **accepted** to UNI once your degree has been conferred  
If you are graduating from UNI with your BA degree, you do NOT need to request these be sent. They will automatically be available to the Department.

**The following forms can be uploaded to your online application, or sent to the Office of Admissions**

- Applicant Statement  
State your desire to enter our graduate-level program, career goals, and the attributes you possess that will make you successful in our program and as a future speech-language pathologist.
- Three (3) letters of recommendation submitted by faculty members  
Recommendations will be requested by applicant via the UNI electronic application process. You will do this by entering their email address.
- Clinical Observation Hours (Only complete form available on website.  
**Do not submit your observation hours at this time.)**
- Resume
